

Begun in 2004 at The Music School of Delaware, The Delaware Women's Chorus was originally conceived as an ensemble for women over the age of 18 who had some choral singing experience and wanted to revisit those skills in a healthy and supportive atmosphere.

Today, still in residence at the Wilmington Branch of The Music School of Delaware, DWC has become one of the Music School's most distinguished ensembles. In 2017 a second chorus, Cantabile Women's Chorus, was established at the Milford Branch of The Music School in the southern part of the state. Under the direction of Joanne J. Ward, both ensembles have doubled in size and consistently perform throughout Delaware, Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Members of the choruses hail from four states; range in age from 20 to 83; and represent a wide variety of ethnicities, life styles and ability levels. All singers, however, regardless of age or ability, come together once a week for two hours with the sincere desire to create beautiful music in an artistic, healthful and supportive environment.
